# Candidates Filing Requirements for Mass Meeting

Candidates seeking the nomination at the Mass Meeting are required to file a statement of intent by mail or in person to Stephen G. Trent, 8973 River Crescent, Suffolk, Virginia 23433, which must be received no later than 12:00 noon on Monday April 8, 2019. Postmarks will not govern. Only those whom have pre-filed will be considered for nomination and no additional nominations from the floor will be in order. If only one person pre-files for the nomination, then the properly filed person will be declared the nominee and the Mass Meeting will be cancelled.

There will be no required registration fee for individuals participating in the Mass Meeting.
