

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting
of the Radford City Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Radford City Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Nishant Grover, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the VFW Hall (102 Watts Street in Radford), starting at 7:00pm local time (registration beginning at 6:30pm) on Monday, January 20, 2020 for the following purposes:

- a) Electing a Unit Chairman;
- b) Electing members of the Unit Committee
- c) Electing up to 85 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 9th District Republican Committee 2020 Convention, to be held on Saturday, April 18, 2020 at George Wythe High School (1 Maroon Way, Wytheville, VA 24382)(or its alternate site) beginning at 10:00am (registration will open at 8:00am and close at 10:15am), for the following purposes:
 - A. Electing District Delegates and District Alternate Delegates to the Republican National Convention to be held on August 24-27, 2020 at the Spectrum Center, Charlotte, NC (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention”);
 - B. Nominating a District Elector to be voted for in the presidential election on November 3, 2020;
 - C. Electing a District Chairman;
 - D. Electing three District Representatives to the Republican Party of Virginia’s State Central Committee (SCC);
 - E. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.
- d) Electing up to 85 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia’s 2020 Quadrennial Convention, to be held on May 1-2, 2020 at the Liberty University Vines Center (or its alternate site), beginning at 2:30pm on Friday 5/1 and 10:00am on Saturday 5/2, for the following purposes:
 - A. Binding Virginia Delegates to the 2020 Republican National Convention as to their choice for President on the first ballot by a Presidential Preference Poll;
 - B. Electing 12 At-Large Delegates (“National Delegates”) and 12 At-Large Alternate Delegates (“National Alternates”) to the Republican National Convention to be held on August 24-27, 2020 at the Spectrum Center, Charlotte, NC (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention”);
 - C. Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 3, 2020;
 - D. Electing a State Chairman;
 - E. Nominating a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman;
 - F. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.
- e) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Radford City is entitled to 18 Delegate Votes.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Radford City under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for the election or nomination at said mass meeting shall file a written statement by email, mail, in person, to Nishant Grover (306 Meadow Ridge Radford, VA 24141 – ngrover460@gmail.com), which must be received not later than Wednesday, January 8, 2020 at 5:00pm. Postmarks shall not govern.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting.

Membership Dues

Membership dues for existing and new unit committee members will be collected during the mass meeting registration.

Couple - \$30 annual dues
