



OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of the Prince Edward County Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

Tuesday, March 24, 2020 at 7:00pm

Crawley Forum, Hampden-Sydney College, 679 College Road, Farmville, VA 23901

(at intersection of College Road & Crawley Drive)

As Chairman of the Prince Edward County Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Daniel Bradshaw, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Crawley Forum, Hampden-Sydney College, 679 College Road, Farmville, VA 23901, or its alternate site, starting at 7:00pm EST on Tuesday, March 24, 2020. Registration begins at 6:00pm and ends at 7:00pm. All those in line at 7:00pm will be able to register. This mass meeting is called for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Unit Chairman
2. Electing members of the Prince Edward County Republican Committee
3. Electing up to 135 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the District Convention of the 5th Congressional District, to be held on Saturday, April 25, 2020 at Tree of Life Ministries, 2812 Greenview Drive, Lynchburg, VA 24502, beginning at 10:00am for the purpose of:
 - a) Election of 3 National Delegates for the 2020 Republican National Convention
 - b) Election of 3 Alternate National Delegates for the 2020 Republican National Convention
 - c) Election of 3 State Central Committee Members
 - d) Election of 1 Elector for the 2020 Presidential Election
 - e) Election of District Committee Chairman
 - f) Election of Republican Nominee for U.S. House
 - g) Transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention
4. Electing up to 135 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention, to be held on May 1-2, 2020 at the Greater Richmond Convention Center, 403 North 3rd Street, Richmond, VA 23219, convening on 5/1 at 2:30 pm and on 5/2 at 10:00 am, for the purpose of:
 - a) Binding Virginia Delegates to the 2020 Republican National Convention as to their choice for President on the first ballot by a Presidential Preference Poll;
 - b) Electing 12 At-Large Delegates (“National Delegates”) and 12 At-Large Alternate Delegates (“National Alternates”) to the Republican National Convention to be held on August 24-27, 2020 at the Spectrum Center, Charlotte, NC in (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention”)

- c) Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 3, 2020
 - d) Electing a State Chairman
 - e) Nominating a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman
 - f) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention
5. Transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Prince Edward County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia participate in this Mass Meeting, subject to the provisions in Article I of the Plan of Organization. Participants may be required to produce personal identification, such as a valid driver's license or Voter Registration Card. There is no registration fee for participants.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for the election of Unit Chairman shall file a written statement by postal mail, email, or in person, which includes your full name, mailing address, and phone number, to Daniel Bradshaw, 228 Lakeside Drive, Farmville, VA 23901, which must be received not later than 5:00 p.m. March 17, 2020 (Postmarks do not govern), or by email to PatriotBradshaw@gmail.com. There is a non-refundable filing fee of \$100.00 to run for Unit Chairman, due by 5:00 p.m. March 17, 2020.

Individuals who wish to be elected Delegates to either the 5th Congressional District Convention or the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention shall file the appropriate delegate pre-file forms attached to this call by postal mail, email, or in person which includes your full name, mailing address, and phone number, to Daniel Bradshaw, 228 Lakeside Drive, Farmville, VA 23901, which must be received not later than 5:00 p.m. March 17, 2020 (Postmarks do not govern), or by email to PatriotBradshaw@gmail.com.

There is no pre-filing requirement to seek election as a member of the Prince Edward County Republican Committee.

Military Members as Delegates

Military Members (any members of the Virginia National Guard, or the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard currently serving on active duty) who comply with these filing

requirements shall not be required to be elected, but shall be declared delegates pursuant to Article VIII, Section H. of the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia.

Military Member delegates or alternate delegates that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots. Instructions regarding the casting of candidate preference ballots are available in the Call for the Convention, which is available on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia (rpv.org)
