OFFICIAL CALL (Abridged) for a Mass Meeting of the Halifax County Republican Party

As Chairman of the Halifax County Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Korey R. Snead, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting of the Halifax County Republican Party **to be held at the Gymnasium of the Mary Bethune Complex** starting at 7:00pm and ending at 8:30pm local time on Friday, July 31st, 2020 for the following purposes:

- a) Electing a Committee Chairman;
- b) Approving pre-filed members of the Halifax County Republican Committee pursuant to the State Party Plan of Organization;

COVID-19 Measures

Due to COVID-19 this will be an ‘unassembled mass meeting’ open to all registered voters of Halifax County who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who are in support of all Republican candidates in the upcoming election. Voting will be conducted from inside of the vehicle via the following rules and procedures:

- Voting will begin for volunteers at 6:45pm. Voting for the general public will begin at 7:00pm and shall last until the last car in line at 8:30pm has voted.
- Voters will enter via Mary Bethune St. and proceed towards the gymnasium, in the back-parking lot, and follow directions to form a line.
- Voters will present an approved voter ID (photo ID or voter registration cards are preferred) to the check-in table, or to one of the volunteers to take to the table, from their vehicle. Once voter registration status and eligibility determined with respect to party rules, the voters will be returned their ID’s and provided with a ticket and a ballot. Once voters receive their ballot, they will pull forward and turn in their tickets and cast their ballots into a locked box (a ticket from check in will be required to cast your ballot).
- Tabulation will not begin until voting is closed.
- No campaigning in line during the event.
- A temporary chairman will be in charge of overseeing the process and ensuring adherence to party rules.
