

OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of The Radford City Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Radford City Republican Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, John W. L. Craig II, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held on May 11th, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. at Veterans of Foreign Wars Building, 102 Watts Street, Radford, Virginia for the following purposes:

1. For the purposes of nominating Republican candidates for constitutional office's for the City of Radford, to include Sheriff, Treasurer, Commissioner of Revenue, and Commonwealth's Attorney.
2. For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of the City of Radford under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for election for Radford Constitutional Offices (Sheriff, Treasurer, Commissioner of Revenue, and Commonwealth's Attorney), shall file a written statement, in substantial compliance to official filing form that is available online at radfordgop.com and file same with the Radford Republican Chairman, John W. L. Craig II or at the Law Offices of John N. Dalton, Jr, 724 W Main St, Radford, VA 24141, or by mail to: The Radford Republican Party P.O. Box 1782, Radford, VA 24143. **All statements (applications for candidacy) must be received no later than noon on May 7, 2021. Postmarks shall not govern.**

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to be considered as a candidate or to attend the mass meeting.

Publication

This call will be published at Radford Republican Party Web site (radfordgop.com) and web site of the Republican Party of Virginia (rpv.org). The Unit Committee has eliminated the requirement to publish this call in a newspaper of general circulation by a two-thirds vote.

The Chairman of the Radford City Republican Committee may move the mass meeting to an alternate location, date and time upon significant hazard or unavailability of the primary location, date and time after giving due notice thereof.
