

#### OFFICIAL CALL

#### Mass Meeting of the Albemarle County Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Albemarle County Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, George M. Urban, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held in the Lane Auditorium, Albemarle County Office Building, 401 McIntire Road, Charlottesville, Virginia, 22902 (or an alternate site, if necessary, as determined by the Chairman), starting at **6:30 PM** local time (with registration opening at 5:30 PM) on Tuesday, **March 15, 2022**, for the following purposes:

- (i) to elect a Chairman of the Committee;
- (ii) to elect Members of the Committee;
- (iii) to elect up to 800 Delegates (and up to 800 Alternates) to the Convention called by the Fifth Congressional District Committee of Republican Party of Virginia for May 21, 2022 (hereinafter the "5th District Convention"). The published 5th District Convention call is hereby incorporated in its entirety into this call (https://virginia.gop/assets/uploads/2022/01/2022-Fifth-District-Convention-Call-2.pdf); and
- (iv) to elect up to 5 Delegates (and up to 5 Alternates) to the Convention called by the Seventh Congressional District Committee of Virginia for April 9, 2022 (hereinafter the "7<sup>th</sup> District Convention"). The published 7<sup>th</sup> District Convention call is hereby incorporated in its entirety into this call (https://virginia.gop/assets/uploads/2022/01/OFFICIAL-CALL VA 07.pdf).

### **Qualifications for Participation**

All legal and qualified voters of Albemarle County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin, or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party within the past five years. A single exception to the preceding shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that s/he is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future.

Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid driver's license or voter registration card in order to participate in the mass meeting. Only those individuals who are **registered** (or are in line to be registered) by 6:30 PM local time on Tuesday, March 15, 2022 will be entitled to participate in the Mass Meeting.

#### **Pre-Filing Requirements for Committee Membership**

Candidates to be Members of the Committee shall file an ACRC Membership Form (attached to this call), by mail to PO Box 5423, Charlottesville, VA, 22905, by email to <a href="mailto:acrcfilings@gmail.com">acrcfilings@gmail.com</a>, or in person as provided in the following sentence. Membership forms may be filed in person <a href="mailto:only">only</a> on Friday, March 11, 2022, from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM local time to George M. Urban at 1236 Hatcher Ct., Charlottesville, VA, 22903.

Membership forms must be received not later than **6:00 PM** local time on Friday, **March 11, 2022**. <u>Postmarks do not govern</u> and it is the responsibility of the candidate to confirm receipt.

Membership dues of \$25 (or higher contribution) must be paid by March 31, 2022, in accordance with our bylaws. Checks should be made payable to "ACRC" and may be submitted with your membership form.

#### Pre-Filing Requirements for 5th District Convention Delegates / Alternates

Only voters who reside in the new  $5^{th}$  Congressional District may be elected Delegate or Alternate to the  $5^{th}$  District Convention. (NB: the vast majority of Albemarle is in the  $5^{th}$  Congressional District.)

Candidates for Delegate or Alternate to the 5<sup>th</sup> District Convention must file the official Delegate Form approved by the district committee (attached to this call), by mail to PO Box 5423, Charlottesville, VA, 22905, by email to <a href="mailto:acrcfilings@gmail.com">acrcfilings@gmail.com</a>, or in person as provided in the following sentence. Delegate forms may be filed in person <a href="mailto:only">only</a> on Friday, March 11, 2022, from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM local time to George M. Urban at 1236 Hatcher Ct., Charlottesville, VA, 22903. All Delegate Forms must be signed; email submissions must be a scan of a hard signed Delegate Form (e-signatures are not accepted).

Delegate Forms must be received not later than **6:00 PM** local time on Friday, **March 11, 2022**. <u>Postmarks do not govern</u> and it is the responsibility of the candidate to confirm receipt.

The district committee requests a **voluntary** delegate fee of \$25 to help defray the costs of the convention. Checks should be made payable to "**Fifth District Republican Committee**" and signed by the delegate candidate; ACRC will submit the checks received to the district committee. You may include this fee with your Delegate Form or pay it online at <a href="http://5thdistrictva.gop/">http://5thdistrictva.gop/</a>.

#### <u>Pre-Filing Requirements for 7th District Convention Delegates / Alternates</u>

Only voters who reside in the new 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District may be elected Delegate or Alternate to the 7<sup>th</sup> District Convention. (NB: a very small number of Albemarle residents in the far northwest live in the 7<sup>th</sup> District.)

Candidates for Delegate or Alternate to the 7<sup>th</sup> District Convention must file the 7<sup>th</sup> District Filing Form (attached to this call), by mail to PO Box 5423, Charlottesville, VA, 22905, by email to acrcfilings@gmail.com, or in person as provided in the following sentence. Filing forms may be filed in person only on Friday, March 11, 2022, from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM local time to George M. Urban at 1236 Hatcher Ct., Charlottesville, VA, 22903. All 7<sup>th</sup> District Filing Forms must be signed; email submissions must be a scan of a hard signed 7<sup>th</sup> District Filing Form (e-signatures are not accepted).

7<sup>th</sup> District Filing Forms must be received not later than **6:00 PM** local time on Friday, **March 11, 2022**. <u>Postmarks do not govern</u> and it is the responsibility of the candidate to confirm receipt.

The 7<sup>th</sup> District requests a **voluntary** Delegate Registration fee of **\$5** to help defray the costs of the convention. Checks should be made payable to "**Seventh District Republican Committee**" and signed by the delegate candidate. You may include this fee with your 7<sup>th</sup> District Filing Form.

#### **Pre-Filing Requirements for Chairman**

Candidates for Chairman of the Committee must file a written declaration by mail or in person, to George M. Urban, 1236 Hatcher Court, Charlottesville, Virginia, 22903, which must be received not later than **5:00 PM** on Thursday, **March 3, 2022**. <u>Postmarks will not govern</u> and it is the responsibility of the candidate to confirm receipt. Nominations for Chairman from the floor will not be accepted unless no candidate for Chairman files by the deadline.

## **Registration Fees**

There will be no registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting.

#### **Cancellation**

If the number of eligible persons properly pre-filed for each office, membership, or delegation above does not exceed the relevant maximum number allowable, then in accordance with the Party Plan each eligible pre-filed person will be declared elected and the Mass Meeting may be canceled by the Chairman.

#### **Publication**

This call will be published on the respective websites of the Albemarle County Republican Committee and the Republican Party of Virginia.
