

OFFICIAL CALL

Party Canvass of the Republican Party of Virginia Beach **(Location Update)**

As Chairman of the Republican Party of Virginia Beach (RPVB), and pursuant to the Plan of Organization as recommended and directed by the committee, I Bill Curtis, do hereby issue this call for a Party canvass to be held the **Meyera E. Oberndorf Central Library, 4100 Virginia Beach Blvd. Virginia Beach 23452 on Saturday 9 April from 12:00 pm until 4:00 pm.** The Chairman shall appoint a canvass committee and a credentials committee which shall decide any questions that may arise concerning the canvass. Canvass rules will be posted to the RPV and RPVB websites. Anyone standing in line at 4:00 pm will be permitted to vote. This canvass is being held for the following purposes:

- a) Electing a Unit Chairman

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Virginia Beach, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its party canvass encompassing their respective election districts. It is recommended that any voter who has registered or changed registration on or after March 1, 2022, also bring a copy of his or her voter registration card to assist in verification.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for the election to the office of unit Chairman, at the canvass, filed a Declaration of Candidacy on Monday 14 March 2022 at the Law Enforcement Training Academy (LETA). Said Declarations of Candidacy were given to Ms. Nanette Miller, the 1st Vice Chairman of the RPVB on that date. (If not more than the number of persons to be elected shall file for the office of Chairman, then such properly filed person shall be declared elected and no canvass will be held for such purpose.

Registration Fee

There will be a \$200.00 registration fee to participate as a candidate for Unit Chairman. The check must be made payable to RPVB and must be turned in with the Unit Chairman Declaration of Candidacy letter.
