

OFFICIAL CALL

MASS MEETING of THE WILLIAMSBURG-JAMES CITY COUNTY REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE

of the REPUBLICAN PARTY OF VIRGINIA

As Chairman of the Williamsburg-James City County Republican Committee (WJCCRC) of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and recommended and directed by the Committee, I Barbara E. Null, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Colonial Heritage Ballroom, 6500 Arthur Hills Dr., Williamsburg, Va. Starting at 2PM local time, with registration starting at 1PM, on Sunday, March 27, 2022, for the following purposes:

- A. Electing a Unit Chairman.
- B. Electing members of the Committee.
- C. For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of the City of Williamsburg and James City County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin, or sex who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting, either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for the election of Unit Chairman at said mass meeting shall file a written statement by mail to Barbara E. Null, c/o WJCCRC, PO BOX 2014, Williamsburg, VA, 23187-2104, or in person to Barbara E. Null, 6419 Isabella Drive, Williamsburg, VA, 23188, which must be received not later than 5:00 PM on March 09, 2022 and

accompanied by a fee in the amount of Three Hundred dollars (\$300.00). Postmarks shall not govern.

All checks should be made payable to WJCCRC.

If the number of persons prefiling as candidates for election or nomination by a Mass Meeting, Party Canvass or Convention does not exceed the number to be elected or nominated for a particular office, the prefilled candidate or candidates may be declared elected or nominated by the Republican Party, if provided for in the call. If the number of persons prefiling as candidates for election or nomination for all offices to be decided upon by any Mass Meeting, Party Canvass or convention does not exceed the number to be elected or nominated, then the candidates may be declared elected or nominated by the Republican Party and the Mass Meeting, Party Canvass or convention may be canceled if provided for in the call.

If the number of persons seeking election as a member of a unit committee or as a delegate to a unit, district or state convention does not exceed the total number allowed by the State Party Plan, all candidates for such office who meet the requirements of Article 1 of the State Party Plan and where required, any prefiling requirements, shall be deemed elected.

Registration Fee

There will be no fee to participate in this mass meeting.
