

**OFFICIAL CALL**  
Mass Meeting  
Pulaski County Republican Committee  
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Pulaski County Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Howard A. McCready, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Pulaski County Courthouse 45 3<sup>rd</sup> St. Pulaski Va (or its alternate site), starting at 7 PM with registration opening at 6 PM local time on Thursday March 24 for the following purposes:

1. To elect a unit chairman, vice-chairman, treasurer, secretary and members to the unit committee;
2. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Pulaski County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party within the last five years. Suspended Republican voters may not vote in the meeting.

A single exception to this shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of this writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception thereafter.

Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid photo ID that is acceptable for voting purposes in order to participate.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for election for Unit Chair shall file a written statement by mail or in person, to Rodger Dean PO Box 7 Pulaski Va 24301 which must be received not later than Monday February 28 at 5 PM and accompanied by required Fee. Postmarks shall not govern.

Official filing forms are available by contacting Rodger Dean, PO Box 7 Pulaski VA or calling 540-235-1225.

Candidacy filing fees are as follows:

- Unit Chairman - \$250.00 filing fee.
- Unit Committee Member – \$25 dues for 1 year. (To be paid with pre-filing.)
- Delegate/Alternate Delegate to the Ninth District Republican Convention - \$ 10.00 registration fee (MANDATORY).

Uncontested Offices/Cancellation of Mass Meeting

*(INSTRUCTIONS FOR THIS SECTION: The committee may choose to hold the mass meeting regardless of how many people have filed for various offices; however, in order to declare a candidate elected when the candidate is the sole candidate to file for an office or to cancel the mass meeting if there are no contested offices, you must use the language below in the form.)*

If no more than one candidate properly files for election to Unit Chair to be voted upon at the mass meeting, that candidate will be declared elected. If fewer than the maximum number of unit committee members that Pulaski County Republican Committee has established pre-file, all properly pre-filed candidates shall be declared elected to the applicable unit committee membership position. If fewer than the maximum number of Delegates that Pulaski County is entitled to at any District convention pre-file, all properly pre-filed candidates shall be declared elected. If there are no contested offices to be voted upon at the mass meeting, then no mass meeting will be held.

Registration Fees for Mass Meeting & Convention

*(INSTRUCTIONS FOR THIS SECTION: Mandatory annual membership fees (to be paid at the time of the mass meeting) may be charged if the committee chooses to hold the mass meeting. Fees are not to be charged if the committee chooses to cancel the mass meeting. The committee may also opt to have voluntary registration fees.)*

There will be a Mandatory annual membership fee of \$25.00 to vote at the Pulaski County Republican Committee Mass Meeting. Please make checks payable to the Pulaski County Republican Committee.

There is a MANDATORY registration fee of \$10.00 for each delegate/alternate delegate elected to the Ninth Congressional District Republican Convention. Fees are requested to be paid at the time of filing for election as a Delegate. Please make checks payable to the Pulaski County Republican Committee, which will forward the registration fee to the Ninth Congressional District Republican Convention.
