

OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of the Falls Church City Members of the Republican Party of Virginia

on

April 20, 2022 at 7:00 PM

American Legion Post 130, 400 N. Oak Street, Falls Church, Virginia 22046

As Chairman of the Falls Church City Republican Committee (“FCCRC”), and pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Jack Blakely, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at American Legion Post 130, 400 N. Oak Street, Falls Church, Virginia 22046, starting at 7:00 PM local time on April 20, 2022, for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Unit Chairman;
2. Electing members of the FCCRC;
3. Electing up to 60 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the District Convention of the 8th Congressional District, to be held on May 21, 2022, at The Waterford at Springfield, 6715 Commerce Street, Springfield, VA 22150, beginning at 10:00 AM for the purpose of:
 - a. Electing a District Chairman;
 - b. Nominating a Republican candidate for member of the U.S. House of Representatives to be voted for at the election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022;
 - c. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention;
4. and such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of the City of Falls Church under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in this Mass Meeting, subject to the provisions in Article I of the Plan of Organization. There is no registration fee for participants.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for election as Unit Chair must file a written statement with Jack Blakely by e-mail at chair@fallschurchgop.org by April 13th, 2020, at 5:00 PM.

Candidates for election to membership of FCCRC, as delegates to the District Convention of the 8th Congressional District must file a statement on the official filing form, which is available on the FCCRC website at <https://fallschurchgop.org/> and shall include with the official filing form a check or evidence of payment of the applicable filing fees as set forth on the official filing form. Filing will be accepted by

mail or electronically if received with the fee or fees listed on the official filing form at P.O. Box 234, Falls Church, VA 22040-0234 , by 5:00 PM, local time, on April 20th, 2022; postmarks shall not govern.

All checks should be made payable to Falls Church City Republican Committee.

Military Members as Delegates

Military Members (any members of the Virginia National Guard, or the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard currently serving on active duty) who comply with these filing requirements shall not be required to be elected, but shall be declared delegates pursuant to Article VIII, Section H. of the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia.

Military Member delegates or alternate delegates that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots. Instructions regarding the casting of candidate preference ballots are available in the Call for the Convention, which is available on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia (<https://virginia.gop/>).

Cancellation

If not more than the number of persons to be nominated or elected shall file for any office, then such properly filed persons shall be declared nominated or elected as the case may be, and no election will occur for that office. Should all elections be cancelled, the Mass Meeting will also be cancelled. A notice of cancellation will be posted on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia (<https://virginia.gop/>).

Publication

This Call shall be posted on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia (<https://virginia.gop/>), and published in a newspaper of general circulation.
