

As Chairman of the Fluvanna Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Darrell Byers, do hereby issue this Call for a Mass Meeting to be held on the date and time and location shown below:

Tuesday, March 21, 2023, at 6:30 PM ET Fluvanna County Library 214 Commons Blvd. Palmyra, VA 22963 OR

An alternate site as determined by the Chairman for the following purposes:

- a) Elect up to 305 and 300 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Senate of Virginia 10th District and the Virginia House of Delegates 56th District respectively, and
- b) Conduct such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting. Fluvanna County will have 61 Delegate votes at the Senate of Virginia 10th District Convention, and 60 Delegate votes at the Virginia House of Delegates 56th District Convention.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION:

All legal and qualified voters of Fluvanna County, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin, or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate in this Mass Meeting.

MASS MEETING REGISTRATION:

For Mass Meeting registration, all participants must be registered voters in Fluvanna County, Virginia, and shall be required to provide proof of identity in the form of a valid government or employer-issued photo identification, or by signing an affidavit of

identity, which will be made available upon sign in. Only those individuals who are registered at the Mass Meeting by 6:00 pm local time on March 21, 2023, or who are in line for registration by that time, will be entitled to register and participate in the Mass Meeting.

Registration Fee:

There will be no registration fee required to participate.

PRE-FILING REQUIREMENTS FOR DELEGATE:

Persons running for Delegate and Alternate to the Republican Party Senate of Virginia 10th District and the Virginia House of Delegates 56th District Conventions to be held on May 6, 2023, and May 20, 2023, respectively must submit an Official Delegate Pre-file Form, in person, by email to dbyers203@gmail.com, or by mail to the Committee Chairman, Darrell Byers, Fluvanna Republican Committee PO Box 114 Palmyra VA 22963.

The Official Delegate Pre-file forms are attached to this call or can be downloaded at the Republican Party of Virginia website, (www.rpv.org), or the 5th District Republican website (https://5thdistrictva.gop). All Delegate forms must be received by 6:00 pm local time on Friday March 17, 2023. Postmarks do not govern.

A \$20.00 contribution is requested, but not required, to help defray the cost of the District Conventions. Checks must be made payable to the Fluvanna Republican Committee. The check must be signed by the delegate candidate named on the Delegate form.

MILITARY MEMBERS AS DELEGATES:

Any Military Member who is otherwise qualified under Article I to participate in Republican Party actions and who complies with the procedures to become a delegate to any Convention as set forth in the Official Call of the Convention, Mass Meeting, or Party Canvass called for the purpose of selecting delegates and alternates to that Convention (other than a national Republican Convention), and who produces valid military identification or other proof of active-duty status shall be certified as a delegate and shall not be required to be elected as a delegate. The number of delegates certified in this manner shall count toward each unit's maximum allowable number of convention delegates.

PRE-FILING REQUIRED FOR RESOLUTIONS:

Resolutions shall not be considered at the Mass Meeting.

CANCELLATION NOTIFICATION: Should no more than 305 and 300 Delegates file for the Senate of Virginia 10th District and the Virginia House of Delegate 56th Conventions respectively, the Mass Meeting may be canceled by the Chairman and the Delegates will be considered elected.
