

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of Hanover County Republican Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Hanover County Republican Committee and pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia (RPV) and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Jack Dyer, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Hanover County Administration Building Board Room, 7516 County Complex Road, Hanover, VA, or its alternate location, at 7:00 PM local time on Thursday, March 23, 2023 for the following purpose:

1. Electing up to 585 delegates and an equal number of alternates to the 10th Senate District Republican Convention to be held on May 6, 2023 at Buckingham County High School, 78 Knights Road, Buckingham, Virginia 23921, or its alternate site, starting at 10:30 AM for the purposes of electing a Republican Nominee for the Senate of Virginia 10th District.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Hanover County in the 10th Senate District, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

The 10th Senate District is composed of the following Hanover precincts:

Ashland District (101-Ashland, 104-Sliding Hill, 105-Berkley)

Beaverdam District (201-Beaverdam, 202-Blunts, 203-Wilmington Parish, 206-Courthouse, 210-Oak Hill)

South Anna District (701-Farrington, 702-Montpelier, 703-Rockville, 704-Elmont, 705-South Anna)

Registration

Registration for the Mass Meeting will begin at 6 PM and will close 15 minutes after the “Call to Order” for the Mass Meeting. Any person in line at this time will be served.

There is no registration fee required to participate in this mass meeting, however every person elected as a Delegate or Alternate Delegate to the 10th Senate District Convention will be asked to pay a voluntary registration fee of \$20.00 to help cover the Convention expenses. This fee will be paid to the delegate’s unit committee.

It is recommended that any voter who has recently registered to vote or moved and changed registration to a precinct in the 10th Senate District be prepared to present a copy of his or her voter registration card to assist in verification. Each candidate for delegate must also sign a statement of intent to support the Republican Party’s candidate in the 2023 General Election.

“In accordance with the Qualifications for Participation set forth in the Official Call and Article I of the Plan of Organization, I do hereby certify that I am a registered voter in Virginia, I am in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and I intend to support all Nominees of the Republican Party

Military Provision

RPV Plan of Organization, Article VIII, H.6

Any Military Member who is otherwise qualified under Article I to participate in Republican Party actions and who complies with the procedures to become a delegate to any Convention as set forth in the Official Call of the Convention, Mass Meeting, or Party Canvass called for the purpose of selecting delegates and alternates to that Convention (other than a national Republican Convention).

Military Members who are unable to attend the convention in person should refer to the Convention Call for details about representation by the military delegation.

Any Military Member who pre-files or registers to be a delegate at the mass meeting, meets the qualifications for participation, and presents his or her military identification or other proof of active duty status will be certified as a delegate.

Pre-filing

Candidates for election as a delegate to the 10th Senate District Convention shall pre-file a written application and, if you chose, the voluntary \$20 registration fee by mail or deliver to HCRC c/o Debbie Agliano, Treasurer, PO Box 6617, Glen Allen VA 23058, not later than 5 PM on March 20, 2023. Postmarks do not govern.

In order to be eligible for election as a Delegate or Alternate Delegate, an individual must be registered to vote no later than the pre-filing deadline of March 20, 2023. A person who has registered to vote and meets all other requirements herein, but whose name does not appear on the local registration books solely because of the books having been closed in connection with a local election, will nevertheless be deemed a legal and qualified voter.

Cancellation

If after consideration of all filings it is found that no election business exists for the Mass Meeting, the Mass Meeting may be cancelled after the filing deadline under the authority of the Chairman of the Hanover Republican Committee by notice methods commensurate with the original publication of the Call.
