 Electing up to 370 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 10<sup>th</sup> District Convention to be held on Saturday, May 6, 2023, at, **Buckingham County High School 78 Knights Road**, **Buckingham**, Virginia 23921 or alternate site. Beginning at 10:30 A.M. for the election of Republican Nominee for the Senate of Virginia District 10 and the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention.

# **Qualifications for Participation**

All legal and qualified voters of Louisa County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the November 7, 2023 election may, as members of the Republican Party of Virginia, be elected as delegates or alternate delegates to this convention, subject to the provisions in Article I of the Plan of Organization.

Mass meeting participants must present one of the forms of identification listed in § 24.2-643 of the Code of Virginia in order to participate as a voting member at the mass meeting.

### There will be NO Registration fee to attend the Mass Meeting and vote.

### Filing Requirements

Candidates for election (Convention Delegates) at this Mass Meeting shall file the proper forms to **Robin Horne by mail to 2562 Peach Grove Road, Louisa, VA 23093 Or anytime in person to Robin Horne.** All forms must be received **Friday, March 17th at 5:00 P.M**; postmarks do not govern. **Robin Horne will be physically available to accept delegate forms on Friday, March 17<sup>th</sup> 2023 at 202 W. Main Street Louisa VA 23093 from 3-5 P.M.** 

Candidates for election as delegate or alternate delegate to the 10<sup>th</sup> District Republican Convention must file the 10th District convention delegate filing form by **Friday, March 17<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 P.M.** A **voluntary** filing fee of \$20 is REQUESTED, but is not REQUIRED by the District Committee. If the filing fee is paid, it should be included with filing form. Checks for the voluntary filing fee shall be made out to the "Louisa County Republican Committee." The convention delegate filing form for the 10th District Republican Convention is attached to this call and is available at <u>virginia.gop</u> and can be requested at <u>louisacountygop@gmail.com</u>. **All forms submitted to the Unit must contain the Delegates Signature**.

### Military Members as Delegates

Military Members (any members of the Virginia National Guard, or the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard currently serving on active duty) who comply with these filing requirements shall not be required to be elected, but shall be declared delegates pursuant to Article VIII, Section H of the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia.

Military Member delegates or alternate delegates that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within the Louisa County delegation according to candidate preference ballot. Instructions regarding the casting of candidate preference ballots are available in the Call for the Convention, which is available on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia, <u>virginia.gop</u>.

### **Cancellation**

If not more than the number of persons to be nominated, properly filed persons shall be declared nominated or elected as the case may be, and no mass meeting will occur. A notice of cancellation will be posted on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia, <u>virginia.gop</u>.
