 - (a) Clerk of the Court
 - (b) Commissioner of Revenue
 - (c) Sheriff
 - (d) Commonwealth's Attorney
- 3. Transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.
- 4. Adjournment

Qualifications and Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Page County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or gender, who are in the accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meeting, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Candidate Filing Requirements

Candidates for election to the offices listed above shall state their intention, via letter, delivered by mail (Page County GOP, PO Box 501, Luray) or in Person to Grayson Markowitz, Unit First Vice-Chair, at the Page County Court House, 117 South Court St, Luray, VA 22835. The letter must be received no later

than 5:00 pm, Tuesday, March 14, 2023. If only one candidate properly pre-files for the nomination for an office, then such properly filed person shall be deemed nominated.

Registration Fee

Proper ID required. There is no registration fee for the Mass Meeting.

Proper Notice

The Call for this Mass Meeting is herewith published on social media sites and forwarded to the Sixth Congressional District Committee. Copies of the Call to be sent via email to all members of the Page County Republican Committee and the Chairman of the Sixth District.

Non-Primary Nomination Method

This call is in conformity with Virginia law and the Republican Party Plan for a non-primary method. A political party using a non-primary nominating method for a general election must nominate its candidate(s) by 7:00 PM on the third Tuesday in June (June 20, 2023) but not earlier than 47 days immediately preceding the primary date (May 4, 2023) established for nominating candidates for the office in question (Virginia Code Section 24.2-510 Deadlines for parties to nominate by methods other than primary). Under the Republican Party Plan a call for a mass meeting must be published not less than seven days nor more than 60 days prior to the mass meeting. The earliest date for a call is March 5 with the earliest prefile deadline of March 14, 2023. (A prefiling period must be at least seven days.)

Approval

The Page County Republican Unit Committee voted at duly called meeting in February 2023: (1) to approve the terms of this Call and, (2) to authorize the Chairmen to change the time, date and/or location of the Mass Meeting if the above chosen location is no longer available.
