

OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of the Amelia County Republican Committee

As Chairman of the Amelia Republican Committee and pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia, and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Martha O'Neal Muniz, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Amelia County Administration Building located at 16360 Dunn Street, Amelia, Virginia, 23002, or its alternative location, on Tuesday, April 7, 2020, starting at 7:00 p.m. local time, for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Unit Chairman and ACRC officers for the two-year term of 2020-2021, and
2. To elect up to 395 Delegates and an equal number of Alternatives to the Republican Party of Virginia's 7th Congressional District Convention, to be held on Saturday, April 25, 2020, at the Arthur Ashe Jr. Athletic Center, 3001 N Arthur Ashe Blvd, Richmond, Virginia 23230, or its alternate site, beginning at 11:00 AM local time, for the purposes of:
 - a) Electing a 7th Congressional District Chairman of the Republican Party;
 - b) Electing three (3) members to the State Central Committee;
 - c) Electing three (3) delegates and three (3) alternate delegates to the Republican National Convention
 - d) Nominating one (1) elector to be voted for the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
 - e) Nominating the Republican candidate for the office of U.S. House of Representatives for the 7th Congressional District; and
 - f) For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention.
3. To elect up to 160 and an equal number of Alternates Delegates to the Republican Party of Virginia Quadrennial Convention to be held on May 1-2, 2020, at the Greater Richmond Convention Center, 403 N. Third St, Richmond, Virginia, 23219 or its alternate site, beginning at 10:00 AM for the purpose of:
 - a) Binding Virginia Delegates to the 2020 Republican National Convention as to their choice for President on the first ballot by a Presidential Preference Poll;
 - b) Electing 12At-Large Delegates ("National Delegates") and 12At-Large Alternate Delegates ("National Alternates") to the Republican National Convention to be held on August 24-27, 2020 at the Spectrum Center, Charlotte, NC in (or its alternate site)(the "National Convention");
 - c) Nominating two At-Large Electors to be voted for in the presidential election on November 3, 2020;

- d) Electing a State Chairman;
- e) Nominating a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman;
- f) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.

The Mass Meeting will commence at 7:00 p.m. Registration shall be open from 6:00 p.m. until 6:45 p.m.

Qualifications for Participation:

All legal and qualified voters of Amelia County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the November 3, 2020 election may, as members of the Republican Party of Virginia, be elected as delegates or alternate delegates to this Mass Meeting, subject to the provisions in Article I of the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia. Delegates and alternate delegates must present one of the forms of identification listed in § 24.2-643 of the Code of Virginia in order to participate.

Military Members (any members of the Virginia National Guard, or the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard currently serving on active duty) who comply with these filing requirements shall not be required to be elected, but shall be declared delegates pursuant to Article VIII, Section H, items 6-8 of the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia. Military Member delegates or alternate delegates that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots. Instructions regarding the casting of candidate preference ballots are available in the Call for the Convention, which is available on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia (<https://virginia.gop/rpv-convention/>).

Mass Meeting Filing Requirements: All Republicans wishing to pre-file to participate in the 2020 Amelia County Republican Mass Meeting, must file the Combined Application/Registration Form and submit it by U.S. Mail to Martha Muniz, P.O. Box 101, Amelia, Virginia, 23002 or to Martha Muniz via email at martha.o.muniz@gmail.com. Postmarks will not govern.

Amelia County Republican Committee (ACRC) Requirements: All persons requesting to be considered for membership in the ACRC must be registered voters in Amelia County and be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party. Applicants must submit the Combined Application/Registration Form accompanied by the \$20.00 annual membership fee by Friday, April 3, 2020 5:00 p.m. Postmarks will not be considered. All others must file during the Mass

Meeting registration period, 6:00 p.m. to 6:45 p.m. on April 7th, 2020. Checks shall be made payable to ACRC.

ACRC Officer Candidate Filing Requirements: Any candidate for Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary and must submit the Combined Application/Registration Form via email to Martha Muniz at martha.o.muniz@gmail.com, or by postal mail, which includes full name, mailing address and phone number, to Martha Muniz, P.O. Box 101, Amelia, Virginia, 23002 and must be received no later than April 3, 2020, 5:00 p.m. Postmarks will not be considered.

Seventh Congressional District Delegate Filing Requirements: All Republicans wishing to be Delegates to the Seventh Congressional District Convention must file the Combined Application/Registration Form and submit it via email to Martha Muniz at martha.o.muniz@gmail.com, or by U.S. mail to Martha Muniz, P.O. Box 101, Amelia, Virginia, 23002 and must be received no later than April 3, 2020, 5:00 p.m. Postmarks will not be considered. The voluntary registration fee is \$25.00 Any delegate who fails to pay the registration fee may participate only in the nomination of candidates for public office (which are the nominees for Congress and the Elector). Checks shall be made payable to ACRC.

Republican Party of Virginia 2020 Quadrennial Convention Delegate Filing Requirements: Republicans wishing to be delegates to the RPV 2020 Quadrennial Convention must complete the Combined Application/Registration form and submit it email to Martha Muniz at martha.o.muniz@gmail.com, or by U.S. mail to Martha Muniz, P.O. Box 101, Amelia, Virginia, 23002 along with the filing fee and must be received no later than April 3, 2020, 5:00 p.m. Postmarks will not be considered. To assist the operations of the Republican Party of Virginia in supporting unit mass meetings and conventions, and the administration of the state Convention, a voluntary Delegate Registration Fee of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) is requested of each person standing for election as a delegate or alternate delegate to the state Convention. Any delegate who fails to pay the registration fee may participate only in the Presidential Preference Poll. Checks shall be made payable to ACRC.

Conduct of the Mass Meeting: The meeting will be conducted in accordance with the Code of Virginia, the Republican State Party Plan of Organization, this Call, and Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised, in that order of precedence. Nominations from the floor for any office will not be accepted, however, if no individual has properly pre-filed for one of the offices of the ACRC, nominations for such office may be entertained at the Mass Meeting from the floor.

Cancellation If not more than the number of persons to be nominated or elected shall file for any office, then such properly filed persons shall be declared nominated or elected as the case may be, and no election will occur for that office. Should all elections be cancelled, the Mass Meeting will also be cancelled. A notice of cancellation will be posted on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia.
