- c) and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation: All legal and qualified voters of **City of Franklin or County of Southampton** under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements: Candidates for election as Unit Chairman, Unit Vice Chairman, Unit Secretary, Unit Treasurer, Unit Member or delegate to any convention at said mass meeting shall file a written statement, on the form provided, in person, at **Fred's Restaurant, 107 S Main St (upstairs), Franklin, VA 23851**, Filing forms can be picked up at **Fred's Restaurant, 107 S Main St (upstairs), Franklin, VA 23851** or online at www.RPV.org.
