LYNCHBURG REPUBLICAN CITY COMMITTEE OFFICIAL CALL FOR A MASS MEETING

As Chairman of the Lynchburg Republican City Committee ("LRCC"), pursuant to the Republican Party of Virginia Plan of Organization, and as recommended and directed by the LRCC, I, Eric Harrison, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting for the following purpose:

Election of delegates to the 2021 Republican Party of Virginia State
Convention (hereafter "the State Convention") on May 8, 2021 at a location
directed by the Republican Party for the purpose of nominating one
candidate each for the offices of Governor, Lieutenant Governor and
Attorney General in the November 2, 2021 general election.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

All legal and qualified voters in the City of Lynchburg under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in this mass meeting.

21 In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in a 22 23 nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party within the last five (5) years. A single exception shall be approved for a voter who renounces affiliation with 24 any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the 25 principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the 26 27 nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter who utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than 28 29 the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception thereafter. Within 30 days of receipt, the Official Committee shall provide a copy of this signed renunciation 30 31 statement to the Republican Party of Virginia, to be maintained for a period of five (5) 32 years.

Any Military Member who is otherwise qualified to participate in Republican Party actions and who complies with the procedures herein to become a delegate to the Convention, and who produces valid military identification or other proof of active-duty status shall be certified as a delegate and shall not be required to be elected as a delegate.

Military Members who are certified as delegates pursuant to the preceding paragraph that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation. Military Member ballots shall be made available by the LRCC Chairman or his designee by April 20, 2021. Military Member Ballots must be received by the LRCC Chairman or his designee no later than 12:30 PM Eastern Daylight Time (hereafter, "EDT") on Wednesday, May 5, 2021.

49 PREFILING OF DELEGATES FOR THE REPUBLICAN PARTY OF VIRGINIA STATE 50 CONVENTION

51 Any individual seeking election as a delegate from the City of Lynchburg to the State Convention **MUST** prefile by submitting a completed "2021 State Convention 52 Delegate Filing Form". The completed 2021 State Convention Delegate Filing Form 53 must be delivered to the Lynchburg Republican City Committee c/o Patsy Walker, 54 Secretary, no later than 8:00 PM EDT on Monday, April 19, 2021. Forms may be mailed 55 56 to the Lynchburg Republican City Committee at Post Office Box 12237, Lynchburg 57 Virginia, 24506, delivered to Patsy Walker at 2432 Indian Hill Road, Lynchburg, Virginia 24503 or scanned and emailed to LynchburgRepublicanCC@gmail.com. Postmarks do 58 not matter. Prefile forms must be actually received by the deadline. 59 Alternatively, an individual seeking election as a delegate may prefile by 60 submitting a form via the LRCC website, 61 https://www.lynchburgrepublicanparty.com/2021-rpv-convention. Online submissions 62 must be received by no later than 8:00 PM EDT on Monday, April 19, 2021. 63

65 REQUIREMENT OF PHYSICAL MASS MEETING WAIVED

66 As there is no cap upon the number of permitted delegates from the City of 67 Lynchburg under the terms of the State Convention call, the requirement of an 68 assembled mass meeting for the purpose of election of delegates is waived.

Pursuant to Art. VIII and Art. XII of the Party Plan of the Republican Party of
Virginia, prospective delegates who comply with the qualifications for participation and
the prefiling requirements herein shall be considered elected as a delegate to the State
Convention.
