### **OFFICIAL CALL**

### for a Mass Meeting of Northumberland County Republican Party

As Chairman of the Northumberland County Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia and of the Northumberland County Republican Party, and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, John Huber, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the The Woman's Club of Northumberland, located at 2890 Northumberland Highway, Lottsburg, Virginia, 22511 starting at 7:00 p.m. local time (doors open at 6:30 p.m. local time) on Wednesday, March 11, 2020 for the following purposes:

- 1) Electing a Chairman of the Northumberland County Republican Committee;
- 2) Electing members of the Northumberland County Republican Committee;
- 3) Electing up to 30 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Convention of the First Congressional District of the Republican Party of Virginia, to be held on Saturday, June 13,2020, at Caroline County High School, 19155 Rodgers Clark Boulevard, Milford, Virginia, 22514 or alternate site beginning at 1:00 p.m. local time for the purposes of:
  - a) Electing a Chairman for the First Congressional District of the Republican Party of Virginia;
  - b) Electing three (3) Members of the State Committee Central Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia;
  - c) Electing three (3) Delegates and three (3) Alternate Delegates to the Republican National Convention to be held on August 24-27, 2020, at the Spectrum Center, Charlotte, NC (or it's alternate site);
  - d) Electing one (1) Presidential Elector to be voted for in the presidential election on November 3, 2020;
  - e) Transacting such other business as may properly come before the convention.
  - f) Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at its last election, so that the Northumberland County Republican Party is entitled to 30 Delegate votes;
  - 2) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.
- Electing up to 30 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Convention of the Republican Party of Virginia to be held on Friday and Saturday, May 1-2, 2020, at the Greater Richmond Convention Center, 403 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Richmond, VA 23219 or alternate site convening on May 1st, 2020 at 2:30 p.m. and on May 2nd, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. for the purposes of:
  - a) Binding Virginia Delegates to the 2020 Republican National Convention as to their choice for President on the first ballot by a Presidential Preference Poll;
  - b) Electing 12 At-Large Delegates and 12 At-Large Alternate Delegates to the Republican National Conventional Convention to be held August 24-27, at the Spectrum Center, Charlotte, NC (or it's alternate site);
  - c) Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 3, 2020;
  - d) Electing a State Chairman of the Republican Party of Virginia;
  - e) Electing a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman of the Republican Party of Virginia;
  - f) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention;
  - Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at its last election, so that Northumberland County Republican Committee is entitled to 30 Delegate votes; and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

#### Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Northumberland County, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions and/or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

#### Filing Requirements

Candidates for the election of Chairman of the Northumberland County Republican Committee shall file the attached pre-file form by mail or in person no later than 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, March 4, 2020, to Elayne Burns, Secretary, Northumberland County Republican Committee, 810 Holly Harbor Rd., Reedville Virginia 22539. Postmarks do not govern. There will be no nominations from the floor of the Mass Meeting for the office of Chairman.

A pre-file form is attached for those persons seeking membership in the Northumberland County Republican Committee, or for those persons seeking to become Delegates or Alternate Delegates for the First District Convention and/or for the State Convention. Forms also will be available at the Mass Meeting.

**Registration Fee** 

There will be NO registration fee to participate in the Mass Meeting. A voluntary contribution of Five Dollars (\$5.00) is requested of each Delegate and Alternate Delegate to the First District Convention to help defray the cost of the Convention. Failure to pay the requested filing fee will not result in disqualification.

To assist the operations of the Republican Party of Virginia in supporting unit mass meetings and conventions, and in the administration of the State Convention, a candidate filing fee of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) is requested of each person standing for election as a delegate or alternate delegate to the State Convention. Failure to pay the requested filing fee will not result in disqualification.

### Military Members as Delegates

#### **RPV Convention:**

Any Military Member who is otherwise qualified under Article I to participate in Republican Party actions and who complies with the procedures to become a delegate to any Convention as set forth in the Official Call of the Convention, Mass Meeting, or Party Canvass called for the purpose of selecting delegates and alternates to that Convention (other than a national Republican Convention), and who produces valid military identification or other proof of active-duty status shall be certified as a delegate and shall not be required to be elected as a delegate. The number of delegates certified in this manner shall count toward each unit's maximum allowable number of convention delegates.


Military Members who are certified as delegates pursuant to the preceding paragraph that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots. Candidate preference ballots shall list the Military Members rank order preference among candidates (i.e., first choice, second choice, third choice, etc.). Their votes shall be cast for the highest ranked choice candidate who remains eligible to receive a vote in a particular round of voting. Candidate preference ballots shall be made available by the RPV Chairman or his designee at least twenty (20) days prior to the convention. Ballots must be returned to Chairman Jack Wilson no later than 12:30 pm on Tuesday April 28, 2020.

### 1st District Convention:

Military Members (any members of the Virginia National Guard, or the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard currently serving on active duty) may be certified as delegates by complying with the procedures detailed in a Unit's call pursuant to Art. VIII, Sec. H, para. 6 of the RPV Party Plan of Organization. Military Member delegates or alternate delegates that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots.

Candidate preference ballots will be made available by the District Committee no later than May 24, 2020 (20 days prior to the convention) on the 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District Republican Committee website, <u>va01republicans.org</u>, or upon a request by email to <u>va01gop@gmail.com</u>. Candidate preference ballots must be received by the District Chairman no later than June 10, 2020 (three days prior to convention) by e-mail to <u>va01gop@gmail.com</u> or by physical delivery to Bob Watson, 6093 Spindle Tree Court, Woodbridge, VA 22193.






