Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Washington County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for the nomination at said canvass shall file a written statement by mail or in person, to Chairman Charlie Hargis, 250 Bogey Dr, Abingdon, VA 24211 which must be received not later than 5 pm on May 18, 2019. If not more than the number of persons to be nominated shall file for each office, then such properly filed persons shall be declared nominated or elected as the case may be, and no canvass will be held for such purpose. A mandatory fee of \$250 is required for Constitutional offices. A mandatory fee of \$100 is required for Board of Supervisor offices. Checks should be made payable to Washington County Republican Committee.
