## Delegate Selection Process Rules of the Republican Party of Virginia

All delegates will be bound on a winner-take-all basis based on the presidential preference vote taken at the Quadrennial State Convention.

3 Delegates and 3 Alternate Delegates will be selected by the Quadrennial District Conventions according to the procedures set out in the convention calls and convention rules, subject to rule 9 for At-Large Delegate and At-Large Alternate Delegate election (i.e., no person may seek election as a delegate or alternate at both a Quadrennial District Convention and the Quadrennial State Convention).

At-Large Delegates and At-Large Alternate Delegates will be elected by the Quadrennial State Convention subject according to the following rules:

- 1. Party Members as defined in Article I of the State Party Plan may qualify to be elected by filing a declaration of candidacy affirming their qualification accompanied by a petition signed by at least 125 qualified voters of the Commonwealth, and a filing fee of \$250.
- 2. The sufficiency of petition signatures shall be certified by the Chairman or his designee using the same criteria under the Code of Virginia for candidates in primaries.
- 3. Informational materials describing these procedures and detailing the costs associated with attending the National Convention will be made available by the Chairman no later than December 15.
- 4. Filings will be accepted at Party Headquarters no earlier than Monday, January 13 at Noon, and must be received no later than Thursday, April 2, at 5 pm. Postmarks will not govern.
- 5. Ballot order will be determined by order of filing. For simultaneous filings, order will be determined by drawing of lots by the Chairman or his designee.
- 6. Candidates for National Delegate will not be entitled to receive contact information of delegates to the Quadrennial State Convention.
- 7. The Chairman will post contact information provided by each candidate for National Delegate on the RPV website.
- 8. At-Large Delegates and Alternate Delegates will be elected on a single ballot where the candidates with the highest vote totals elected as delegates and the next highest vote totals as alternates. A tie for the final delegate slot or the final alternate slot will be broken by drawing of lots.
- 9. No person may seek election as a delegate or alternate at both a Quadrennial District Convention and the Quadrennial State Convention.
