 DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY FOR OFFICER, MEMBER & DELEGATE
 PCRC PARTY CANVASS, 7TH DISTRICT CONVENTION
 AND
 REPUBLICAN PARTY OF VIRGINIA STATE CONVENTION**

I, _____, a registered voter in Powhatan County, submit this form for purposes of complying with the requirements set forth in the Official Call for a Party Canvass with respect to the following:

- I hereby file my candidacy for Membership in the Powhatan County Republican Committee. Attached is a check for annual dues in the amount of \$20.00 for the year 2020. Dues will be billed for the year 2021. Deadline for filing as member is March 18, 2020
- I wish to be elected Chairman of the Powhatan County Republican Committee. I have included my non-refundable filing fee of \$250.00 – Deadline for filing as Chairman is February 29, 2020, 5:00 pm
- I wish to be a Delegate to the State Convention of the Republic Party of Virginia on May 1-2, 2020, Deadline for filing as Delegate is March 18, 2020, 5:00 pm;
- I have included my voluntary payment of \$35 as required to participate in all matters to come before the State Party other than the participation in the Presidential Preference Poll; Deadline for Filing Fee is March 18, 2020, 5:00 pm;
- I wish to be a Delegate to the Seventh Congressional District Republican Convention on April 25, 2020, Deadline for filing as Delegate is March 18, 2020, 5:00 pm;
- I have included my payment of \$25 as required to participate in all matters to come before the District Committee other than the nomination of a candidate for public office. Deadline for Filing Fee is March 18, 2020, 5:00 pm

NOTE: Article VII, Section C of the Republican Party of Virginia’s Plan of Organization states the following about membership on a county committee:

A member of an Official Committee is held to a higher standard of support for nominees of the Republican Party than an individual who merely participates in a mass meeting, party canvass, convention or primary. Therefore, a member of an Official Committee is deemed to have resigned his Committee position if he (a) makes a reportable contribution to and/or (b) allows his name to be publicly used by and/or (c) makes a written or other public statement in support of a candidate in opposition to a Republican nominee in a Virginia General or Special Election.

By signing this form, I certify that I am a registered voter in Powhatan County, have read and understand the requirements above and that I intend to support all nominees of the Republican Party during this election (for convention delegates) and/or during my two-year term as a member of the Powhatan County Republican Committee. Also, I have read and understand other requirements herein including, but not limited to Article I of the Plan of Organization which states in part:

A voter who, subsequent to making a statement of intent, publicly supports a candidate in opposition to a Republican nominee shall not be qualified for participation in party actions as defined in Article I for a period of four (4) years.

Payments to the Powhatan County Republican Committee are not tax deductible.
