

## **Challenges to Delegates on the Roll of Delegates**

Challenges to any delegates must be made no later than Noon on Friday, August 7. Challenges must be submitted by e-mail to [2020-Convention@rpv.org](mailto:2020-Convention@rpv.org). Anyone making a challenge must specify the reason for the challenge and provide any relevant evidence. Challenges may be based only on the Qualifications for Participation in Article I of the Party Plan or a procedural issue relating to the election of delegates by in a unit process. The delegate or delegates challenged will be provided an opportunity to respond to any challenge. As a courtesy to the Credentials Committee and the challenged delegate, anyone make a challenge should provide the challenged delegate with a copy of any submission to the Credentials Committee.

## **Individuals Improperly Excluded from the Roll of Delegates**

Individuals who believe they should be on the Delegate Roll should first contact the chair of their unit committee. Unit chairs may have helpful information to clarify any issue and the Credentials Committee will benefit from input from the Unit Chair. After contacting the unit chair, such individuals should submit their cases by e-mail to [2020-Convention@rpv.org](mailto:2020-Convention@rpv.org). Such cases can be considered at the unit polling location on the day of the Convention, but resolution by the Credentials Committee in advance are more likely to be successfully resolved.
